Industry-Recognized Credential Requirements

To earn an Industry-Recognized Credential or group of credentials, you must do one of the following:

Option 1	Option 2	Option 3
Earn a 12-point approved Industry-Recognized credential.	Earn credentials totaling 12-points within one career field.	Earn a state-issued license for practice in a vocation that requires an exam.

If you meet one of the requirements above, this will also earn you your Industry-Recognized Credential Seal for Graduation!
